

Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed? ² For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, There is no beauty that we should desire Him. ³ He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with

grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him. ⁴ Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our ^[h] sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. ⁵ But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes^[m] we are healed. ⁶ All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all. ⁷ He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, So He opened not His mouth. ⁸ He was taken from prison and from judgment, And who will declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; For the transgressions of My people He was stricken. ⁹ And they made His grave with the wicked—But with the rich at His death, Because He had done no violence, Nor was any deceit in His mouth. ¹⁰ Yet it pleased the Lord to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, And the pleasure of the Lord shall prosper in His hand.

Hello Vegan Gourmet Club members,

This note is just to connect with you and remind you that at this time we are not having our regular Vegan Gourmet Club meetings until further notice. At the way the California projections are running we may not be able to meet until June. We might try to come up with something like a live stream in May, so stay tuned.

We hope that you are all following the physical distancing and at home isolation according to the guidelines. We do recommend that if you go out in public to wear a mask. Short of reducing your exposure to the coronavirus, there are still things you can do to enhance your immunity.

A whole food plant-based diet enhances your immunity in many ways. In addition, adequate sleep, physical exercise (jumping to conclusions and running up bills don't count) and stress management also enhance or prevent deterioration of your immunity. Hopefully your are taking advantage of stay at home time by doing more home cooking, better meal prep, getting more exercise, finding more time for meditation or prayer and self care.
