

Greetings Church family,

As many of you have heard, the President and the Governor of California declared that churches have the right to re-open their facilities. The original intent was to open at phase 3 of the pandemic, allowing for a safer recovery to local families that desire a community driven worship experience.

The Southern California Conference announced on Wednesday, May 27, at 3:30 pm, that Local SDA Churches can re-open if they fulfill all the requirements the local county and conference have mandated. Upon viewing the documents and analyzing what is best for Camarillo SDA Church, I decided to bring this issue of reopening to our local church board to determine the best course of action.

The Camarillo Church board discussed possibilities for 1 hour and 30 minutes. After much discussion, we came to the conclusion that reopening the facilities at this point is not worth the risks. The list of requirements are extensive: deep cleaning the church before use, 6 feet social distancing, tracking where people can sit, bathroom usage, temperature checks, hand sanitizer stations, and required masks for everyone.

That is the physical component. We still need to include the restrictions. Members and visitors who are 65 years or older are highly recommended to not attend church. No praise teams, congregational singing, or choirs are to be performed. No Sabbath Schools for children. Children are to be with parents at all times. No potlucks, no children's stories at the front of the church. No hugging, touching, elbow bumping, etc., At a certain point, we feel that the restrictions are steep and can destroy the worship experience. Therefore, with the new guidelines, I will be exploring new ways to enhance our worship experiences through livestream. Before we were limited to 5 people in the room by the Conference Standards, 6 people in Ventura County. This opens up possibilities for more participation from the congregation while being less restrictive by an in-person requirement. I will be exploring this with the conference next week to see what our options are and how we can best assist in creating a worship experience for you and meet some of your communal needs.

Thank you for your patience and dedication to Lord during this time.

# NAD Issues Response to Recent Deaths and Racial Turmoil in U.S.

The Seventh-day Adventist Church in North America is responding to the tragic killings of Ahmaud Arbery in Georgia, Breonna Taylor in Kentucky, George Floyd in Minnesota, and other recent events that clearly document the racial divide destroying the quality of life for so many and the very fabric of our democratic society. As Christians we condemn such actions of hate and violence and call for justice to be served for the victims and their families.

Walls of separation that serve to destroy the essential rights of human dignity, self-worth, and freedom have been built up. These rights are required for all Americans to live and thrive in their local communities. Some of those who have been trusted to protect all members of society have broken their solemn pact to serve others; especially those in need. Americans should never have to live in fear of going out in public just because of the color of their skin or their ethnicity. We can and must do better.

We urge all our church members to prayerfully consider how they interact with everyone in their communities. We ask you to speak out against injustice and hatred, just as Jesus did when He was on this earth. We can make a difference for those who are marginalized and betrayed by others, and we must provide a forum for the voices of the victims of hatred and racism. They must be heard as we serve to heal our broken communities with the love and compassion of Jesus.
