Hello Camarillo Church family,

Covid-19 has created a very interesting time for all of us to be a part of. We have seen so many changes to our basic way of living. There is no doubt that things will never be the same at this point. Also, with the changes, it almost feels as if there is no end to the pandemic in sight. This leaves a very big question in the minds of many of us: what will happen to the church?

Since the first weekend that Covid-19 hit the United States back in March, Camarillo has offered a worship service of some kind through live stream services. Although the services have been limited due to county and church restrictions, we have always tried to provide some nourishment and support during this wild time. The guidelines have been constantly adapting: Changes to singing, physical attendance, occupants in a room, size of the building restrictions, and many other rules like these are changing monthly.

In the first week of July, State of California mandated that churches close their indoor services again. The restriction to this guideline is specifically to IN-DOOR activities, but excludes outdoor participation. Camarillo leadership feels that the community aspect of the church family has been waning as of late and we were already looking into reopening the doors before July restrictions were implemented.

We, at the Camarillo SDA Church, are happy to inform you that we will be **holding in-person church services live outdoors** starting **SABBATH, JULY 18, 2020.** Now, I'm sure this creates a ton of questions, and hopefully I will be able to answer some of them in this letter.


- 1.) <u>Adult Sabbath School</u> will be held <u>in person in the parking lot</u> every Sabbath morning at <u>9:30am</u> and church <u>Worship Services</u> will be at <u>10:45am</u>.
- 2.) Health restrictions will be applied to the services. This means that the 6 ft. social distancing applies to non-family members at all times. We will be separating spaces by parking squares to insure that families can keep a safe distance from one another safely.
- 3.) **BRING A MASK AND YOUR OWN WATER**. The drinking fountain will be closed off from usage during the service to limit the potential spread of COVID-19. We would also encourage you to bring your own chairs and potentially a tent if you would like some extra comfort. We will not provide seating at this time. Think of it similarly to church at the beach.
- 4.) Use the Restroom before coming to church. The Men's and Women's restrooms will be available, but we would love to limit the usage as much as possible. The bathroom services will be limited to one person at a time.
- 5.) IF you do not feel comfortable coming to church, there will still be a live stream service that I will be recording the day before. I do not want the outdoor weather to negate the message and

- tone of the service at this point. We may look into wind resistant microphone protectors in the future, but this is where we are starting for this week.
- 6.) Also, if you have a family member, or you yourself, are at high risk, please consider staying home during this time. There is no guarantee that the church family is COVID free. The church is cleaned and monitored constantly, but that doesn't remove the risk.
- 7.) There will be an offering plate to drop off tithe envelopes. There will also be some hand sanitizers that we will have around the church property to provide some support to you.

PRAISES: From Bill Calkins (7/24): "I didn't expect to be doing this 20 some hours after the procedure, but my left eye is now seeing better that it has for over 60 years! It has been deadly sharp from 6 to 15 inches for a long time, but now it's sharp from 20 inches to the moon! That may change of course; we were aiming for sharp at arms length (matching the right eye repaired many years ago). Of course it's much brighter and the colors are all there (I was missing purples, blues and yellows), but the big deal is that the images seen by both eyes are just about the same size. Before the right eye saw an image 15% larger than the left eye and it was a mighty computer chore for the brain to match the two images. Right now, I can see the venetian blinds, the mesh of the window screen, the hanging plants outside the window, the fence, and I can clearly read the name of the school across the street all with the left eye. What a great blessing. . . God is very good to his children! Keep smiling, and thanks for all the good wishes and prayers."

HEALTH CONCERNS: Lynda Millar (Evelyn DeLay's daughter) – surgery Fri., July 24); John Negley, Sr. (cancer); Dottie Hula (Suzanne Goodrich's mother) - hospice care; Henry Hernandez (pinched disc and calcium deposits on neck); Linda (sister of Yoli Hernandez) - Covid-19; Lisa Matthew's mother; Dorothea Amey (cancer); Mike Godfrey - (stroke recovery); Sharon Croombs-Schwartz (recovery from colon cancer surgery 7/14); Gershon Napod's Mom - esophageal cancer, and Gershon's brother Levi; Naomi Turner; Clinton Hooper (Chad's brother) - surgery recovery; Evelyn DeLay; Jay Cummings; Larry Miller (serious health issues).

John Negley Sr. has a diagnosis of cancer and a treatment plan that will keep him alone — no visitors — for 5 weeks. What we can do is two-fold: pray earnestly, and "visit" him by phone. That is a long time to be alone and in a scary situation. His cell # is 813-862-8989. (We have his permission to list it) Now —what if it were you? This is a great time to remember the golden rule and to pour out our prayers to the Great Physician. Thank you!

<u>UPDATE</u> (July 11): **Lisa Matthews** has requested our prayer chain to pray for her **mother**. Her mother is not eating much, cannot walk by herself at all, and is not doing at all well. Lisa fears she may not be around much longer—and is not allowed to visit her in assisted living. Please lift her up in your prayers to our compassionate Savior.

Yoli Hernandez: The doctor has decided to reschedule Henry's July 10 surgery due to new physical complications that would affect his fusion surgery healing and recovery... leg numbness causing muscle weakness, not being able to balance when standing and walking. Doc is rescheduling an MRI for his legs. He is consulting with a carpal tunnel doc. Maybe they will do those surgeries first. Henry has really gone down, not being able to walk and balance are priority to healing after a cervical surgery because you won"t be able to move the upper part of your body for weeks. One needs to depend on walking. Sees the doc on the 22nd. They may schedule more tests in between. Please keep praying.

From Sharon Croombs-Schwartz: My son has coronavirus. My niece Amber, 37, received news that her cancer has spread ... She has 4 children, twins age 12, one 2 1/2 and one 6 months. She has been raised with new age teachings and is really confused, spiritually. Please pray for God to reach her with His word of love and peace. **UPDATE: Amber** came home from 10 days in the hospital (June 15). She is receiving no treatments at this point. She still needs prayer as there is nothing they can do for her cancer. *We continue to pray for her salvation.*
