Thank you for your continued support of Linda Vista Adventist Elementary. God's hand is leading us in wise decisions, careful expenditures and open "pocketbooks" on the part of our supporters.

During last school year, from July 1, 2011, through June 30, 2012, the debt was reduced by \$36,468 leaving us with a balance of \$38,608. At the present rate of reduction we plan to have this cleared by June 30, 2013. We have moved the modular home in for security purposes and the Dan Allen family moved in July 1, 2012. Our enrollment is holding at around 68 to 72. Thank you faithful partners!

It is very enriching and we believe it has made a huge difference.
