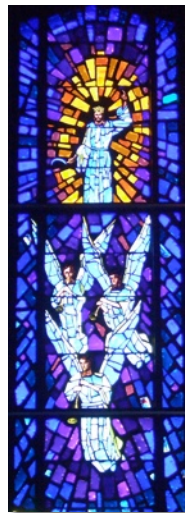

CHURCH RENOVATION: Thank you to all who have given to the church building fund. We need your ongoing support for this major project that is now in progress. Your generosity is much appreciated.

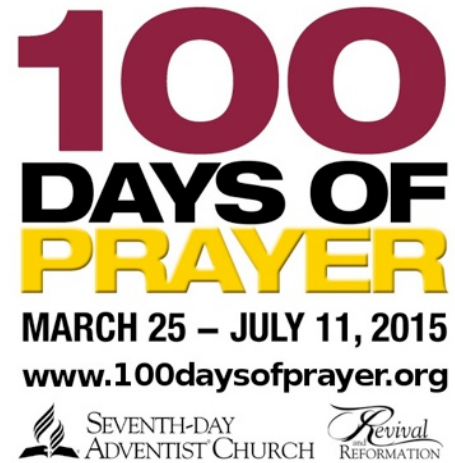
