Hello Vegan Gourmet Club members (and interested friends),

This note is just to connect with you and remind you that at this time we are not having our regular Vegan Gourmet Club meetings until further notice. At the way the California projections are running we may not be able to meet until June. We might try to come up with something like a live stream in May, so stay tuned. We hope that you are all following the physical distancing and at home isolation according to the guidelines. We do recommend that if you go out in public to wear a mask. Short of reducing your exposure to the coronavirus, there are still things you can do to enhance your immunity.

A whole food plant-based diet enhances your immunity in many ways. In addition, adequate sleep, physical exercise (jumping to conclusions and running up bills don't count) and stress management also enhance or prevent deterioration of your immunity. Hopefully your are taking advantage of stay at home time by doing more home cooking, better meal prep, getting more exercise, finding more time for meditation or prayer and self care.
