Sharon Croombs-Schwartz – cancer treatment; Sharon Croombs-Schwartz's son - COVID-19, and her niece Amber - terminal cancer (please continue to pray for her salvation).

Latest news from Sharron Croombs/Schwartz: "I start oral chemo on Aug. 17 so I ask for prayer that the side effects will be such that I can continue to lead my little school through this difficult year. The chemo is to catch any cancer in my lymph... I am at a stage 3A cancer which is highly responsive to chemo and has a good prognosis. I am 75, a healthy 75, I am told but still. The Lord knows my length of days and I have planned treatment to give me quality of life and the best chance at eradicating cancer. I am O.K. with wherever God leads. He is trustworthy."

John Negley Sr. has a diagnosis of cancer and a treatment plan that will keep him alone — no visitors — for 5 weeks. What we can do is two-fold: pray earnestly, and "visit" him by phone. That is a long time to be alone and in a scary situation. His cell # is 813-862-8989. (We have his permission to list it) This is a great time to pour out our prayers to the Great Physician. Thank you!

Dorothea Amey-- **UPDATE** (Aug. 10): "I was unconscious in the hospital for three days. I woke up with a ventilator. I had an extreme reaction to chemo and almost lost my life. 
